WHEREAS, our Founding Fathers, in order to secure the blessings of liberty for themselves and their posterity, did ordain and establish a Constitution of the United States of America, the oldest Constitution in use in the world today; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens fully understand the provisions and principles contained in the Constitution and Bill of Rights in order to support it, preserve it and defend it against encroachment; and

WHEREAS, the 209th Anniversary of the signing if the Constitution provides a historic opportunity for members of Mount Lookout Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution and all Americans to reflect on the rights and privileges of citizenship as well as its responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the independence guaranteed to the American people by the Constitution will be celebrated by appropriate activities during Constitution Week, September 16 - 23, 1996 as designated by proclamation of the President of the United States of America in accordance with Public Law 915.
