

ORDINANCE NO. 891

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO ESTABLISHING COURT COSTS FOR THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that persons who plead guilty to or are convicted of charges in Berthoud's Municipal Court should be responsible for paying the costs of operating and administering these judicial functions; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to §13-10-113(3), C.R.S., the judge of the municipal court may assess costs which are established by the Board of Trustees against any defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere or who enters into a plea agreement or who, after trial, is found guilty of an ordinance violation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1. Assessment of Costs.

The judge of Berthoud's Municipal Court shall assess costs of \$15.00 against any defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere or who enters into a plea agreement or who, after trial, is found guilty of an ordinance violation.

Section 2. Effective Date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting March 27, 2001, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 10th day of April, 2001. After the public hearing, the Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 10th day of April, 2001.
