

ORDINANCE NO. 816

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 769 OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Paragraph A. of Section 18-6-140 of Chapter 18 entitled "Impoundment Fees" is hereby amended to read as follows:

18-6-140 Impoundment fees.

A. The keeper having charge, care, custody or control of any animal shall be liable for all fees and charges incurred as a result of the impoundment of the animal. The Town or any independent contractor with whom the Town has agreed to provide impoundment facilities shall not release any animal impounded until all fees incurred are paid. Currently an impoundment fee of \$25.00 and a boarding fee of \$8.00 per day shall be collected from any person owning, or having charge, care, custody or control of any animal impounded pursuant to this Title or who voluntarily surrenders an animal to the Town for euthanization or adoption.

Section 2. Effective Date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting February 23, 1999 a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 16th day of March, 1999. After the public hearing, the Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 16th day of March, 1999.
