

ORDINANCE NO. 815

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 6 of TITLE 13 OF THE DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1.

The first sentence of Section 13-6-120 of the Development Code is hereby repealed and amended by the following two sentences to read as follows:

There is established a utility advisory board consisting of five regular members and not more than three alternate members. Not more than two of the regular members may reside outside the Town limits, providing that those commissioners who reside outside the Town receive utility service from at least one Town utility.

Section 3. Effective Date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting February 23, 1999, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 16th day of March, 1999. After the public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 16th day of March, 1999.
