

ORDINANCE NO. 812

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SUPPLEMENTAL FEE FOR PROPERTIES USING WATER PRESSURE PUMPS, INCLUDING THE AREAS SERVED WITH TREATED WATER, IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD IN LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the maintenance, repair and reconstruction of water pressure pumps generate costs which are directly attributable to the users of these pressure pumps; and,

WHEREAS, these costs should be allocated among the properties being served by the water pressure pumps;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1.

a. The Town of Berthoud shall assess a fee of \$4.75 per month for every residential and commercial water tap served by the Berthoud Lake Ranchettes water pressure pump.


b. The fee shall be billed monthly and be due and payable with the monthly user fee for each property.

Section 2. Emergency Clause.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds that the adoption of this ordinance is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the Town and an emergency exists justifying the adoption of this ordinance and it shall take effect immediately upon passage this 12th day of January, 1999 by a vote of 7 for and 0 opposed.
