

ORDINANCE NO. 979

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 2003 BUDGET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, LARIMER and WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT;

Section 1. WHEREAS, during 2003, the Town of Berthoud determined the General Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$40,198 of unappropriated revenue be applied to the operations for the engineering services; and

Section 2. WHEREAS, during 2003, the Town of Berthoud determined the Conservation Trust Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$62 of unappropriated revenue be applied to the operating costs of mosquito control; and

Section 3. WHEREAS, during 2003, the Town of Berthoud determined the Debt Service Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$8 of unappropriated revenue be applied to the operating costs for bank services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecast at the time the 2003 Budget was drafted and that these expenditures were necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety; and


WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, which jeopardizes the fiscal welfare of the Town and would affect the health and safety of its citizens. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its final passage and adoption.

At the meeting held on December 9, 2003, the Board of Trustees voted to enact this Ordinance.
