

ORDINANCE NO. 971

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING TITLE 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. - Curfew for Use of Public Parks

Berthoud's Municipal Parks shall only be open to the public from sunrise until thirty (30) minutes after sunset, unless prior written permission for use or occupancy has been obtained from the Town of Berthoud or unless the use is while playing tennis at the tennis court. Being present in Berthoud's Municipal Parks outside this time period or without prior written permission of the Town of Berthoud shall be unlawful and punishable by a fine of not more than \$300 for each offense.

Section 2. - Emergency Clause

The Board of Trustees has heard the comments of persons who live near the Town's parks and trustees have personally observed activities by individuals that jeopardize the health, safety and welfare of the Town's citizens.


Section 3. - Effective Date

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.


