

ORDINANCE NO. 943

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 939 WITH REGARD TO RAW WATER DEDICATION METHODS IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud has determined that the volatility of the prices for the acquisition of raw water, coupled with its unavailability and any drought conditions, place the Town in a precarious position with regard to properly evaluating and controlling, on a timely basis, the adequacy of the methods and quantity of the raw water which the Town receives;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 939 is hereby amended with the following addition:

D. Notwithstanding the requirements in subsections A, B and C above, the Board of Trustees, after notice and public hearing, may modify any one or more of the three methods of satisfying the raw water dedication requirements by the passage of a resolution which may modify any or all of these methods to more adequately address the needs of the Town of Berthoud; the availability of raw water; the status of any drought; the price for the raw water; and, the status of any litigation with respect to this raw water.

Section 7. Effective Date:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.


At its meeting July 9, 2002, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 23rd day of July. After the public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 23rd day of July, 2002.
