

ORDINANCE NO. 910

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION AND ZONING OF LAND TO THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COUNTY OF LARIMER, STATE OF COLORADO, TO BE KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS THE YEAGER 1ST ANNEXATION TO THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO

WHEREAS, a Petition for Annexation together with seven copies of a Plat of said land as required by ordinance were filed with the Town of Berthoud by the owners of one hundred percent (100%) of the area of the land hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by motion at its regular meeting accepted said Petition and found that the Petition substantially complied with the statutory requirements set forth in Sections 31-12-104, 31-12-105 and 31-12-107, C.R.S.; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that an election is not required under Section 31-12-107(2), C.R.S., as provided in Section 31-12-111, C.R.S.; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that additional terms and conditions were not to be imposed and that the Petition was signed by owners of one hundred percent (100%) of the property proposed to be annexed, exclusive of streets and alleys. Therefore, in accordance with Section 31-12-107, C.R.S., the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud has determined that an ordinance to annex such land to the municipality should be considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1.

The land described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is hereby annexed and shall be known and described as the Yeager 1st Annexation to the Town of Berthoud:

The parcel described on Exhibit "A" contains approximately 12.098 acres more or less, and shall be zoned T-Transitional.

Section 2. Effective Date:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after publication.

At its meeting December 11, 2001, the Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 11th day of December, 2001.

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YEAGER 1ST ANNEXATION

That portion of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter and of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 4 North, Range 69 West of the 6th P.M., Larimer County, Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the North Quarter Corner of said Section 22; thence along the North line of the Northwest One Quarter of said Section 22 South 89 04'41" West, a distance of 712.00 feet to the True Point of Beginning, said point being on the Easterly right-of-way of the Coleman Ditch; thence along said Easterly right-of-way line the following four (4) courses:

- 1) South 00 39'14" East, a distance of 59.50 feet;
- 2) South 40 20'02" East, a distance of 204.13 feet;
- 3) South 01 50'20" West, a distance of 142.43 feet;
- 4) South 63 42'38" East, a distance of 653.20 feet

to a point on the North-South centerline of Section 22 from which point the North Quarter Corner of said Section 22 bears North 00 10'13" West, a distance of 658.15 feet; thence North 87 48'46" West 1323.56 feet to the West line of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 22; thence along said West line and its Northerly prolongation North 00 11'06" West 616.50 feet to the North right-of-way line of Highway 56, said right-of-way line being parallel with and 30 feet North of said North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22; thence along said right-of-way line North 89 05'03" East 610.31 feet; thence South 00 39'14" East 30 feet to the True Point of Beginning.

Containing 12.098 acres more or less.
