

ORDINANCE NO. 1086

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF BIMSON AVENUE WITHIN THE NORTHEAST PORTION OF THE MARR-WHITE-DECKER ANNEXATION, TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO.**

Section 1.

WHEREAS, THE Board of Trustees has reviewed the circumstances for the requested vacation of a portion of Bimson Avenue being described as follows:

That certain portion of the Marr-White-Decker Annexation to the Town of Berthoud, County of Larimer, State of Colorado shown as a forty (40) foot road reservation, lying in the Northeast portion of said Marr-White-Decker Annexation to the Town of Berthoud, County of Larimer, State of Colorado.

And;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has received the recommendation from Town's staff and all other affected utility companies that this portion of Bimson Avenue be vacated because it is not presently being used and it is not anticipated that it will ever be used;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO;

Section 2.

That portion of Bimson Avenue described above and further depicted on the Road Reservation Vacation Land Survey Plat which is incorporated herein by reference and which was previously dedicated to the Town of Berthoud, is hereby vacated.

Section 3.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting on April 22, 2008, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting on the 13th day of May, 2008. After the public hearing, the Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 13th day of May, 2008.
