PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Colorado Children's Campaign has declared the 1990s THE DECADE OF THE CHILD IN COLORADO in order to show our commitment to our children; and

WHEREAS, the Campaign has called upon all citizens of Colorado to join together in a statewide mobilization that will raise awareness about the problems facing children in our state, what is being done to address these problems and what still needs to be done,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the TOWN OF BERTHOUD, affirms the 1990s as THE DECADE OF THE CHILD IN COLORADO and further resolves to join forces with the others in a statewide effort to improve children's lives by making them our number one prority.
