WHEREAS, the Multiple Sclerosis Society of Colorado is committed to assisting, managing and curing people affected by this disease and helping their families; and


WHEREAS, the Multiple Sclerosis Society of Colorado needs the support and cooperation of the public in order to carry on its good work;
