**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF
THE 2021 BUDGET**

WHEREAS During 2021, the Town of Berthoud determined the 1998 1% Sales Tax Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs. The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$170,000 of the unappropriated revenue be applied to street improvements including Safe Routes to School; and

WHEREAS During 2021, the Town of Berthoud determined the 2019 1% Sales Tax Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs. The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$964,245 of the unappropriated revenue be applied to Waggener Farm Park construction; and


WHEREAS the Board of Trustees determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecasted at the time the 2021 budget was drafted and that these expenditures were necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the Berthoud community; and

TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**


