

**RESOLUTION NO. 8-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CONTINUITY  
OF OPERATIONS PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN**

**WHEREAS** the Town of Berthoud is subject to natural and human caused disasters which interrupt basic law enforcement and public safety services; and

**WHEREAS** planning for continuation of municipal services to the public is a basic and necessary function of local government; and

**WHEREAS** the Larimer county Sheriff's Office, which provides Berthoud law enforcement services, and the Fire District have proposed to coordinate the development of a Continuity of Operations plan for the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, Town staff has requested that funding in the amount of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) be appropriated for the Town's costs of development and implementation of such program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

The sum of thirty thousand dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund to meet initial expenses of the Town in developing and implementing a Continuity of Operations Plan for Municipal Services in the event of a disaster;
