

RESOLUTION NO. 1-08

CONCERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A TRANSFER OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A SEGMENT OF OLD STATE HIGHWAY U.S. 287, FROM MILE POST 325.09 TO MILE POST 325.43 AND MILE POST 327.03 TO MILE POST 328.99, TO THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD IN LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, State Highway U.S. 287 is part of the State Highway System, and under Section 43-2-102, Colorado Revised Statutes (CRS), the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) has the responsibility to maintain State Highway U.S. 287; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission of Colorado has the responsibility, under Section 43-2-102, CRS to formulate the general policy with respect to such maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission also has the authority under Section 43-2-106, CRS to abandon portions of the State Highway System which are no longer needed as a State Highway; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission, through Resolution Number TC-1492, has determined that a portion of Old State Highway U.S. 287 from Mile Post 325.09 to Mile Post 325.43 and Mile Post 327.03 to Mile Post 328.99 is no longer needed and should be abandoned; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission has determined that no land owners will suffer damages due to this action, provided the Town of Berthoud accepts the abandoned portion of U.S. 287 as a part of the Town's street system; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Berthoud, in Larimer County, Colorado will accept and assume the full maintenance responsibility and ownership of that abandoned portion of Old State Highway U.S. 287 from Mile Post 325.09 to Mile Post 325.43 and Mile Post 327.03 to Mile Post 328.99.
