

RESOLUTION NO. 20-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO TO IMPLEMENT A SCHEDULE OF MEETINGS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRODUCING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS (IGAs) CONTAINING FORMAL MECHANISMS TO MANAGE GROWTH IN BERTHOUD'S URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARIES AS ESTABLISHED IN THE TOWN'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud has adopted a Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Town of Berthoud, the counties of Weld and Larimer, the City of Loveland, and the Towns of Johnstown and Mead, for all parties to negotiate IGAs for the purposes of implementing cooperative, coordinated and consistent development.




