A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING AND SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN AGGRESSIVE LOSS CONTROL PROGRAM FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD.

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud is extremely conscious of the safety of our employees and the citizens of our community; and,

WHEREAS, we recognize our obligation to ensure the safest possible work place for our employees; and

WHEREAS, as a governmental entity, we recognize our responsibility to provide a safe environment for the public we serve; and

WHEREAS, it is our belief that most accidents are preventable; and


WHEREAS, it is our belief that loss control responsibilities are continuous and equal in importance with all other operations considerations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

The Board fully supports the development of an aggressive loss control program for the Town of Berthoud, to include the formation of a Safety Committee, the appointment of a Safety Officer, and the designation of responsibility to all department heads and supervisors to complement the efforts of the safety coordinator to reduce accidents and provide for the safety of our employees and the public we serve.

This resolution was introduced, read and adopted by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud in the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2003.
