

RESOLUTION NO. 13-98

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE QUALITY OF CUSTOMER SERVICE AND THE CONSERVATIVE RATES PROVIDED TO THE CUSTOMERS OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD BY POUUDRE VALLEY REA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the citizens' best interests to evaluate the acquisition of Public Service Company of Colorado distribution system within the Town of Berthoud; and,

WHEREAS, Poudre Valley REA provides service to more than 300 residences and the Berthoud High School; and,

WHEREAS, the quality of service provided by Poudre Valley REA is high and the rates are conservative; and,

WHEREAS, it is not the intention of the Town to require that the current customers of Poudre Valley REA buy power from the Town of Berthoud if it acquires the electrical distribution system owned and operated by Public Service Company of Colorado.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The distribution system of Poudre Valley REA in the Town will not be purchased by the Town of Berthoud until REA's customers vote to have the system purchased by the Town or until the Town is able to document the fact that it could provide those customers reduced rates and service which would be at least as reliable as the service being provided to them as REA's customers.

At the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on June 23, 1998 this resolution was read and adopted by a vote of 4 in favor and 1 opposed.
