

RESOLUTION NO. 6-95

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A LARIMER COUNTY ONE QUARTER OF ONE PERCENT (0.25%) SALES AND USE TAX TO FUND THE ACQUISITION, PROTECTION, IMPROVEMENT AND LONG-TERM MAINTENANCE OF OPEN SPACE, NATURAL AREAS, WILDLIFE HABITAT, PARKS AND TRAILS.

WHEREAS, the Town adopted a comprehensive plan that encourages and promotes open space, the protection of natural areas and wildlife habitat and parks and trails and the Board believes it should promote the acquisition and preservation of these; and,


WHEREAS, Berthoud, as a community, is committed to parks and open space and its character is rooted in those ideals. Many members of this community have worked very hard to see that Berthoud was included in the Larimer County Comprehensive Parks Master Plan. Continuing and supporting that effort by this Board is critical.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud support a voter approved one quarter of one percent (0.25%) sales and use tax annually to commence January 1, 1996 and end on December 31, 2003 to fund acquisition, protection, improvement and long-term maintenance of open space, natural areas, wildlife habitat, parks and trails, as more particularly described in the Help Preserve Open Spaces Initiative.
