

RESOLUTION NO. 12-, 1994

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS FRONT RANGE CITIES AND TOWNS AND LARIMER COUNTY FOR REGIONAL PLANNING.

WHEREAS, the cities of Fort Collins, Greeley, and Loveland and the towns of Berthoud, Evans, Milliken, Wellington, and Windsor, and the Board of Commissioners of Larimer County, Colorado have determined to maintain physical separation between the various cities and towns to retain unique identities and distinct boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to establish a coordinated program of regional planning and growth management to achieve the desired result; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the project, not to exceed \$75,000.00 shall be borne proportionally by each of the parties; and

WHEREAS, Fort Collins shall be responsible for administration of the project; and

WHEREAS, all appropriations shall be made by all parties prior to engaging in a contract for the performance of services to achieve the desired result.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the attached Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the Town of Berthoud with the cities of Fort Collins, Loveland, and Greeley, the towns of Evans, Milliken, Wellington, and Windsor and the County of Larimer for maintaining and enhancing physical separations between the various cities and towns.

2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
