

RESOLUTION NO. 10-94

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE BERTHOUD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AS ITS DESIGNATED EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY (DERA) IN THE EVENT OF A HAZARDOUS MATERIAL INCIDENT WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado (Town), has determined and hereby determines and declares that the interests of the Town and public safety and necessity require that the Town designate the Berthoud Fire Protection District as its Designated Emergency Response Authority (DERA) in the event of a hazardous material incident in the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. Designation. The Berthoud Fire Protection District has the manpower and training to safely and effectively deal with any hazardous material incident that may occur in the Town.


Section 2. Declaration of Official Intent. This Resolution is intended to be a declaration of "official intent" to designate the Berthoud Fire Protection District as its Designated Emergency Response Authority.


Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval
