

RESOLUTION NO. 8-93 (as amended)

A RESOLUTION TO ENSURE THE COORDINATION OF THE INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES AND PAVING FOR SECOND OR FOURTH STREETS IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authorization by the citizens of the Town of Berthoud a 1% sales tax fund has been created to provide the Town's share of the funds necessary for oversizing of pavement for Second or Fourth Streets and collection of this 1% sales tax will conclude in July of 1994; and,

WHEREAS, financing the installation of paving, curbs, gutters and sidewalks on Second or Fourth Streets, removal or relocation; and,

WHEREAS, there are currently utilities located over and under these streets which may require replacement, removal or relocation; and,

WHEREAS, the long term costs to the citizens of the Town of Berthoud will be significantly reduced if all utility and paving activities are properly coordinated; and,

WHEREAS, any petition to form a special improvement district for the purpose of installing paving and related improvements on Second or Fourth Streets requires approval at a municipal election under Article X, Section 20 of the Constitution of the State of Colorado;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud that:

1. At least one general informational meeting outlining these projects shall be scheduled and conducted by the Town's staff;

2. The project shall be designed to coordinate the installation of utilities and paving for Second or Fourth Streets in the Town of Berthoud and to ensure the installation of a new water main under Fourth Street to replace the existing main.

3. At such time as a petition to form the necessary special improvement district is filed with the Town, the Town's staff shall establish a schedule to place this issue on the ballot for the April election.

This resolution was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting this 25th day of January, 1994.
