

RESOLUTION-1987

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud owns certain water rights which have historically been diverted through the Handy Ditch and delivered to the Town's water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the Town has filed an Application in Case No. 84CW421, Water Court for Water Division No. 1, to authorize alternate points of diversion which would not use the Handy Ditch, but would require the construction of a pipeline from Carter Lake to deliver water to the Town's water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Town has done preliminary investigations concerning the location, alignment, and construction of said pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to proceed with more detailed planning for construction of said pipeline at the earliest feasible time; and

WHEREAS, the Town has provided for capital expenditures of this type in its 1988 Budget through capital expenditures appropriation in excess of \$150,000; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Berthoud Town Board that, upon entry of a final decree in Case No. 84CW421 Water Court for Water Division No. 1, the Board shall proceed with detailed studies of and planning for construction of the pipeline and other facilities necessary to deliver water to the Town's water treatment plant from Carter Lake.
