I, Carol A. Mayo, Clerk of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, do hereby certify to the Division of Local Government in the Department of Local Affairs that the following is a true and correct copy of the motion as made at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, October 9, 1973 and recorded in the Minute Book.

Trustees John Cooper moved, Trustee John Erickson seconded to adopt the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that the budget of the Town of Berthoud as heretofore filed, considered and amended by the Board of Trustees at a regular meeting held on October 9, 1973, be set at 21.1 mills on the \$2,442,180 valuation; 3 mills for general purposes, 12.5 mills for General Obligation Bonds, 5.1 mills for Swimming Pool Bonds, and .5 mills for the Library, to be assessed upon every dollar of assessed valuation of taxable property within the Town and that the Clerk file a copy with the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Larimer, Colorado requesting them to set the above levy.

Roll call was taken and the six Trustees present voted YES. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
