New Equipment Coming to Bein Park

Residents will soon be able to experience Bein Park’s newest fitness equipment! The new fitness equipment along the trail will be upgraded this month following recommendations from Berthoud’s Parks, Open Space, Recreation, and Trails Committee (PORT). The current fitness stations in the park will be replaced with various obstacle course features, suitable for children ages 5-12. In total, eight new obstacles will be installed that will challenge children’s jumping and climbing abilities. **Stop by to try out the new equipment at 199 S 10th St, right next to Berthoud High School.**

Berthoud Trails

Berthoud continues to work on trail connectivity throughout the area. The South Berthoud Parkway trail gap was recently completed and now connects trails from Waggener Farm Park to Spartan Avenue. Work will continue with the Town and Developers to complete the last trail section in this area. Future segments will connect Village at Rose Farm and Rose Farm heading southeast to bring residents to Hillsdale Park. This work is expected to be completed by the Rose Farm Village developer before the end of the year. Be sure to check out Berthoud’s existing and future trails at www.berthoud.org/trails-masterplan.

2022 1st Street Corridor Plan

Planning is underway for Berthoud’s 1st Street Corridor, which extends between Mountain Avenue and US 287. We’ll be reviewing present and future needs of the corridor and will establish preferences and priorities based on our findings. The final Plan will provide the Town of Berthoud with a roadmap for to achieve community objectives along for the corridor for many years to come.

Approximately 35 people attended a public project introduction meeting on July 21st that offered participants an opportunity to provide feedback on corridor planning and design priorities. The next public workshop is September 14th, 2022, from 6 – 7:30 pm at Northern Water, 220 Water Avenue. This second open house event will display draft concepts that will guide the design, development, redevelopment, and growth of the corridor. Public input on the draft will serve as a guide in the preparation of a preferred concept, which will be the subject of a third public workshop in October.
