

Trails Master Plan

In September 2021, upon completion of The Town of Berthoud Open Space Plan and Comprehensive Plan Update, a need emerged to prepare an update to the 2018 Unified Trails Master Plan. The Board of Trustees approved a revised plan which includes an updated existing trails map, a trails master plan map, new design guidelines, action items and planning level costs based on information collected during the previous planning efforts and new emerging developments.

Town staff worked with the Logan Simpson consulting team throughout the past six months to engage neighboring communities. Staff listened to public comments and Larimer/Boulder/Weld County staff reps, as well as held open interviews with Trustees, the Planning and Zoning commission, and the PORT committee members. The PORT Committee recommended approval of the 2022 Trails Master Plan draft at the February 2022 meeting, with the addition of a potential trail to be added to the map along 1st St.

Part of Berthoud's Community Identity is being a great place to visit and recreate. Over the years, public surveys have shown increased support for new parks, open space, additional recreation amenities, and a connected trail system throughout Town. Our growing trail system will continue to create alternative transportation routes for commuting, wild life viewing, and improving the health and wellness of our community.

LETA

The Town of Berthoud would like to remind residents to sign up for LETA. Larimer Emergency Telephone Authority, LETA911, is the Governing Authority for 9-1-1 in Larimer County Colorado.

LETA911 provides oversight to 9-1-1, the equipment, and the programs funded by LETA. Within this county region there are five 9-1-1 call centers, thirty government entities, one State University, and one National Park. If you live, work, or are visiting Larimer County, you are covered by LETA programs, emergency alert system, and various other programs like Text to 9-1-1, that are available in our area.
