

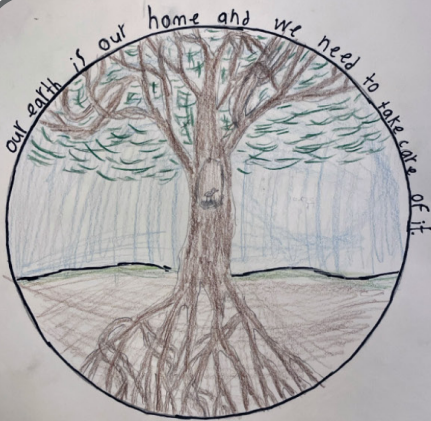

Meet the Team: Forestry & Open Space

With Earth Day and Arbor Day, April is a month dedicated to nature. What better time to introduce you to Berthoud's Forestry and Open Space Departments? The Forestry Team is made up of two people; Paul Furnas, Town Forester, and Brandon Koons, Forestry Tech. Both Paul and Brandon hold degrees from Colorado State University in Horticultural Sciences and are ISA Certified Arborists. The Forestry department is responsible for the health and maintenance of Berthoud's urban forest, including planting, pruning, treating, and removing trees. The team also helps enforce codes regarding trees in the right of way, educates the public on our town's trees, and maintains Berthoud's recognition as a Tree City USA.

In the Open Space Department, Tyler Parker is Open Space Lead, and Austin Miller is Open Space Technician. Tyler grew up in Berthoud and earned a degree in History from the University of Wisconsin Lacrosse. Austin served in the Air Force and earned a Natural Resource Tourism and Recreation degree from Colorado State University. The Open Space Department is responsible for maintaining Berthoud's beautiful natural areas, including trail and facility maintenance, cleaning up trash, weed mitigation, and mowing parts of our natural areas.

Paul says, "Our staff is motivated by a shared appreciation for the natural world; this is why we are so excited about the Fifth Annual Arbor Day poster Contest and Arbor Day Celebration."

NOCO Alert

Living in Colorado has its benefits, but it is not without its dangers. Protecting yourself and your family is essential as we enter storm and fire season. If you haven't already done so, now is the best time to sign up for local emergency alerts through NOCO Alert. Visit its website to sign up at NOCOAlert.org or text BERTHOUD to 888777 for emergency and community alerts, including West Nile virus spraying.

This Larimer County Emergency Alert System allows a message to be sent to you if there is a life-threatening emergency in your area. You opt-in and enter the contact information for addresses you care about in Larimer County. The information you provide is protected and not used for any other purpose.

Larimer County also maintains an emergency information line at (970) 498-5500, where important incident information is recorded as needed. In significant events, they frequently staff their Information Center and respond to questions with public information officers as well. Much of the same emergency information will simultaneously be posted to www.larimer.org/emergency. You can also subscribe to that page for automatic e-mail updates to keep abreast of any emergency developments.

Berthoud's Community Clean-Up Event: April 28 - May 13

It's almost time for Berthoud's annual Community Clean-Up Event. Swing by Town Hall any time after April 20th during regular business hours, Monday – Thursday, 7:00 am – 5:30 pm, and pick up your landfill voucher. Then, go through your garage, basement, and closets, pile up the useless clutter, and haul it to the Larimer County landfill. With your voucher, the Town will cover the cost of dumping most items. Tires, electronics, and appliances with freon, however, will be subject to additional fees. *(Residents must pay any extra fees at the main gate.)* Visit www.Larimer.org/solidwaste for complete information and restrictions.
