Berthoud Marks 41 Years As A Tree City, USA

Join us at Bein Park on Saturday, April 27th, at 10:00 AM to celebrate Arbor Day and plant a ceremonial Hackberry tree to commemorate Berthoud's 41st year as a Tree City USA. Refreshments will be available, and there will be a drawing for a sapling Spring Snow Crabapple.

In honor of Arbor Day, elementary school children in grades 3-5 are encouraged to create an 8.5" x 11" poster celebrating the awesomeness of trees for the **6th annual Arbor Day Poster Contest**. One winner from each grade will win a baby Blue Spruce they can plant at home! Entries are due by April 25th, and winners will be announced at Bein Park during the Arbor Day celebration. Sewer Line Replacement

The Town is well on its way with the construction of the 1st Street Trunk Sewer Improvements Project. The project is focused on making some modifications and improvements to the sanitary sewer collection system that will divert flow from the 1st Street Trunk Sewer, which is nearing its maximum capacity. This work is located in three spots in town. The first is at 4th Street and Water Ave. This work is complete, with the exception of some final restoration work on the street and right-of-way. The second area is in the alley between 3rd and 4th Streets from Massachusetts to Bunyan. This involves replacing a problematic 6" sewer line with a new 8" diameter line. Lastly, the existing 12" 1st Street trunk was repaired in a couple of locations (behind Pioneer Sand and Gravel and just north of the Northern Water campus). This will relieve some restrictions limiting the trunk sewer's capacity. The work is expected to be completed by the end of May.

2024 Sidewalk Plan

This year's sidewalk improvements will begin where the 2023 improvements left off. ADA-compliant sidewalk repairs and ramp replacements will start on Lake Ave., 6th St., and Turner Ave. The remaining scheduled 2024 improvements will take place on 7th St., Massachusetts Ave., 9th St., and Welch Ave. Please visit www.Berthoud.org/Streets to view the 5-Year Sidewalk Improvements Plan and map to view the exact locations for this project.

Larimer County also maintains an emergency information line at (970) 498-5500, where vital incident information is recorded as needed. During significant events, they frequently staff their information center and respond to questions with public information officers (PIOs). Much of the same emergency information will also be posted to www.larimer.org/emergency.
