

ORDINANCE NO. 967

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES,
COLORADO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 944 REGARDING THE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE
USE OF WATER

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1.

In order to permit consumers to irrigate more conveniently, the current
restrictions as to irrigation on specific days or methods are to be repealed and
therefore Section 1 of Ordinance No. 944 shall be repealed with the exception of the
last sentence of the first paragraph which shall be amended to read:

No irrigation shall be permitted between the hours of 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.
with the exception that micro-irrigation using hand watering, soaker hoses, drip
irrigation and irrigation of newly laid sod and newly seeded lawns may be done at any
time.

Section 2. Emergency Clause.

The Board of Trustees has determined that storage of water in reservoirs
remains below average historical levels. It is therefore necessary to continue to
conserve water to ensure that there will be sufficient water in storage to provide the
citizens of the Town with an adequate supply of water through June of the 2004.
An emergency exists justifying the passage of this Ordinance to take effect and be in
force immediately upon passage.

At the regular meetings of the Board of Trustees on June 10, 2003 and June 24,
2003, this Ordinance was set for a public hearing on July 1, 2003. After the public
hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published this 1st day of July,
2003 by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed.
