Berthoud's Municipal Code 6-14

Residents of Berthoud should be aware of Municipal Code 6-14, which permits irrigation only between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. This regulation is designed to promote water conservation, but following these guidelines helps preserve local water resources and supports your lawn's health by preventing overwatering, which can lead to fungus and oxygen-deprived roots.

Tips for Efficient Lawn Watering

- Water early in the morning: This reduces evaporation and allows water to soak deeply into the soil.
- Adjust your sprinkler heads: Ensure they water the lawn, not sidewalks or driveways.
- Check for leaks: Even small leaks can waste a substantial amount of water over time.
- Use a rain sensor: This can prevent your system from running during or after rain.

By taking these steps, you can ensure your lawn stays healthy and green while conserving water. It's a win-win for your yard and the environment!

Even on a day that doesn't seem hot to you and even in the shade, never leave your pet alone in a parked vehicle.
