Whereas, Beginning in 1986, Stan dedicated his career to serving the Berthoud Community at Turner Middle School and Berthoud High School until his retirement from teaching in 2016; and

Whereas, After retiring from teaching in 2016, Stan continued serving as Turner's Athletic Director for an additional four years until 2020; and,

Whereas, Over Stan's three decades in Berthoud, his contributions extended far beyond the classroom as he coached football, baseball, track, and boys' and girls' basketball at both Turner and Berthoud High School; and,

Whereas, Throughout the years, Stan generously and consistently contributed to the Turner community by helping facilitate dances, the annual Bob Turner Classic 5K Race, and the Stan Kaufman Co-Ed Relay which raised over \$3,000 annually for six years. All these things to the benefit of Turner Athletics; and,


