Berthoud to Celebrate Arbor Day with Ceremonial Tree Plantings at Pioneer Park

BERTHOUD, CO (April 10, 2025) – The Town of Berthoud invites residents to celebrate Arbor Day and the community's 42nd consecutive year as a Tree City USA with a special event at **Pioneer Park on Saturday, April 26**. The celebration, hosted by the Town's Forestry Department, will begin at 10:00 AM and feature several ceremonial tree plantings. Community members are encouraged to grab a shovel and help plant seven new Maple trees alongside the Forestry team. "Arbor Day's not just about planting trees; it's about growing something together that'll last for generations," says Mayor Will Karspeck. "It's one of the ways we show how much we care about our town and each other." The event will also include drawings for a sapling Spring Snow Crabapple tree and a garden starter kit. **The winners of Berthoud's 7th annual Arbor Day Poster Contest will also be announced**, with each young winner walking away with a Dwarf Alberta Spruce tree and a feature spot in the 2026 Arbor Day Poster calendar. All are welcome to join in this celebration of trees and environmental stewardship. Complimentary coffee and donuts will be provided.
