As part of its transformation, the new community garden is fully inclusive, featuring garden beds at three different heights: 32 inches, 24 inches, and 17 inches. All entries and exits to the garden are ADA-approved, ensuring accessibility for people of all ages and abilities. This thoughtful design allows everyone in our community, from young children to seniors and those with mobility challenges, to participate and enjoy gardening together.

Each season, the garden is planned, planted, and harvested by a passionate team of volunteers who love sharing their time and knowledge. We're always happy to welcome new faces, whether you're an experienced gardener or just getting started. It's also a fantastic way to meet new people, learn a few new gardening tricks, and enjoy the outdoors.
