Town of Berthoud Water Quality Tests Comply with State Regulations

The Town of Berthoud is pleased to announce that its latest home water tests comply with the State of Colorado's Department of Public Health and Environment's strict standards. Over the last 18 months, a small percentage of water test samples showed elevated levels of lead and copper in the water taken from resident's homes. As soon as the levels were discovered, staff at the Berthoud water treatment plant began developing a treatment plan to correct the leaching of lead and copper from home fixtures and into the drinking water.

A corrosion control program was implemented in early 2015. The program adjusts the pH at the water treatment facility so that the water is not as corrosive, yet the water's taste and aesthetics are not altered.

The Town of Berthoud is committed to providing the best tasting and highest quality drinking water for the community. The Town will continue testing samples according to the State's requirements.
