## TOWN BUSINESS: COORDINATION AND TEAMWORK

Your Town's Administration Office is responsible for significant business practices that keep the Town operating 24/7. Many of the duties filled by Town staff in Administration require direct interaction with community members and businesses, plus coordination and teamwork with colleagues across the organization.

### SERVICES PROVIDED

- **Town Administrator's Office**  
Responsible for day-to-day operations of the Town including managing staff and personnel issues, attending stakeholder and citizen meetings, overseeing Town budget and ensuring the Board direction is followed.
- **Town Clerk**  
Collects and compiles information for Board meeting packets and logistics for the Board, supports the municipal court, is the custodian of records, recruits and supports Boards and Commissions, administers municipal elections, oversees liquor and medical marijuana licensing and passport applications, and assists with Town employment processes.
- **Municipal Court**  
Operates as a Limited Jurisdiction Court and hears cases such as traffic violations, animal, code violations, and parking citations. Municipal Court is held on the third Thursday of each month in Town Hall at 9:00 a.m.

Within the year, Town Administration and most Town departments will relocate to the new Town Hall, 807 Mountain Ave. A public open house and tours of the building will be scheduled at that time as well. 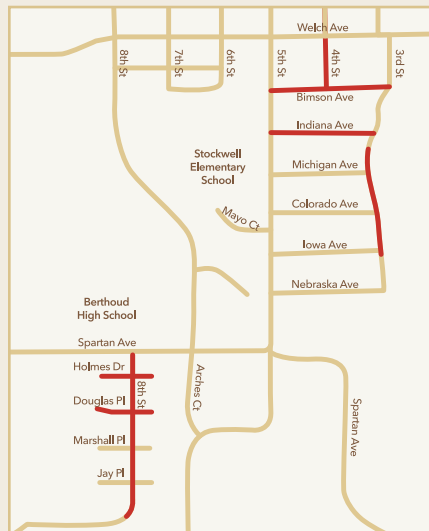
