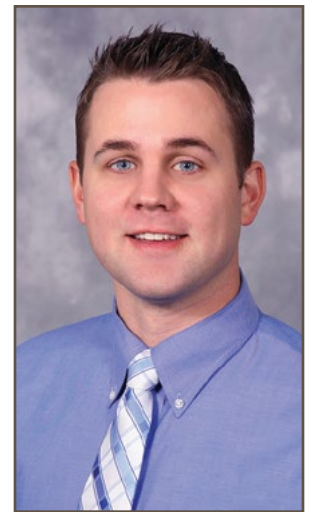




## BERTHOUD WELCOMES NEW TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

The Town Board of Trustees officially appointed Christopher Kirk as the new Town Administrator for the Town of Berthoud. Chris will join the Berthoud organization on January 22, 2018. Chris brings 10 years of local government experience, coming from Tehachapi, California as a member of the City Manager's Executive Team. In addition to his undergraduate degree, Chris also holds a Master of Public Administration degree from California State University, Bakersfield.



Chris has experience spearheading initiatives including strategic planning, branding, and capital improvements. In his role as Assistant City Manager, he and his team successfully completed nearly \$10 million in road, water, wastewater, beautification and building projects. Chris is committed to bring the same enthusiasm and success to the Town of Berthoud.

The Berthoud Town Board selected the new Town Administrator after a thoughtful and diligent hiring process. After a thorough interview process that included interaction with Town staff and community members, the Board determined that Chris's experience, goals, and energy aligned best with the Town of Berthoud and the community.

### COLD WEATHER CARE

Our area is no stranger to cold weather. So, it's important to keep our pipes protected against freezing temperatures. Here are a few suggestions to help to prevent pipes from freezing:

- Open kitchen and bathroom cabinets to allow warmer air to circulate.
- When the weather is very cold outside, let the cold water drip from the faucet served by exposed pipes. Running water through the pipe - even at a trickle - helps prevent pipes from freezing.
- Keep the thermostat set to the same temperature both during the day and at night.
- If you will be away during cold weather, set to a temperature no lower than 55° F.
- Keep garage doors closed if there are water supply lines in the garage.



## ARE YOU INTERESTED IN SERVING AS A TOWN BOARD MEMBER?

On April 3, 2018 the Town of Berthoud will be conducting a mail ballot election for Town Board Offices and Mayor.

Candidate packets are available in the Town Clerk's Office at 807 Mountain Ave. Nomination petitions may only be circulated January 2–22, 2018.

### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RUN FOR ELECTED OFFICE, YOU MUST:

- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Be a resident of the Town of Berthoud or of a territory annexed to that ward for at least 12 months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Be currently registered to vote.

### TO HAVE YOUR NAME APPEAR ON THE APRIL 3, 2018 BALLOT, YOU WILL NEED TO:

- Collect ten (10) valid signatures on your nomination petition.
- It is highly suggested to have more than the minimum of ten signatures, as it is possible that not all signatures will qualify.
- All signors must be eligible to vote in the Town of Berthoud.
- Do not separate the pages of your petition.
- Have the Circulator's Affidavit notarized - Do not have the affidavit notarized until you have finished gathering signatures on your petition.
- Complete the Acceptance of Nomination form.
- Deliver all completed materials to the Town Clerk's office, 807 Mountain Avenue, Berthoud, Colorado 80513, no later than **January 22, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.**
